corporation with the help of Dale W. Storer, an attorney in Idaho Falls, Idaho and one of the original six missionaries called to Indonesia. Meldon truly enjoyed working with everyone involved with JFI.

Because of illness from Covid 19 in January 2021, a five month hospital stay, and ongoing rehabilitation, it became necessary for Meldon to retire from his work with the corporation. Larson

will be replaced by Handi Mulia, a native of Indonesia. Interestingly, when then Elder Larson was serving as a missionary in Jakarta in January 1973, he helped teach Handi's family and witnessed his baptism.

Handi and his wife, Wendy Mulia, studied in BYU Hawaii for two years then transferred to BYU Provo. Handi obtained his mas-

ter's in civil engineering in 1986 then moved to Los Angeles to work as a structural and bridge engineer for 11 years before transferring to South Jordan, Utah in 1997 to work on the I-15 Reconstruction Project for the 2002 Winter Olympics. They decided to stay in Utah after the project was done. Handi strongly believes in helping those in need to pursue higher education and obtain marketable skills. Handi

and Wendy are blessed with two children, Amanda and Mardi, and one granddaughter.

Larson served in the Southeast Asia (Indonesia) mission from October 1971 to November 1973. In January 1974 he attended the Church College of Hawaii (now BYU-Hawaii) where he taught in the first Indonesian Zone of the Language Training Mission. Meldon graduated with a bachelor's in accounting from BYU-Hawaii in June 1977.

Larson met his wife, Amor Consuelo deKeyser while attending school. Meldon also worked as the campus Bookstore Manager and Assistant Controller in Hawaii. In 1989 they moved to Provo where Meldon worked at BYU as an internal auditor. Together they decided to go back to school and each obtained a master's in public administration degree in 1993. For his work at BYU Meldon also became a Certified Internal Auditor and Certified Fraud Examiner. He retired from BYU in May 2014. Meldon and Amor are the parents of two daughters and grandparents of twins, a boy and a girl.
